

## The Boy Who Saved His World Brochure Activity

### Materials:

1. Copy of the Story or CD of "The Boy Who Saved His World"
2. Chart Paper
3. Markers
4. Brochure Template
5. 5w's1h organizer
6. White construction paper for final brochure

### Activity Procedures:

1. Listen to "The Boy Who Saved His World- A story of citizenship, patriotism, courage, and caring" on CD or read to whole class.
2. Ask discussion questions.
3. After the story is read, ask the students these questions
4. Who was the main character? What was the problem? How did he fix it? How did he, all by himself, "save his world"? What could have happened if he didn't help?
5. Ask the students to help you brainstorm things in their community that need someone's help. (food collection for local pantry, money and supplies for SPCA, trash clean up at local park, etc)
6. Write ideas on chart paper
7. Hand out the 5w's 1h organizer
8. Tell students that they are going to make a brochure to tell people how they can help fix one of these problems.
9. Have students write in an idea on their organizer, of their choice from the chart that they want to tell people about.
10. Have students fill in the information they will need to include on their brochure. If they need help, allow them to research on the computer.
11. Give students the brochure template to fill in, design, and color.
12. Have students share their brochures with classmates and other classes in the school.

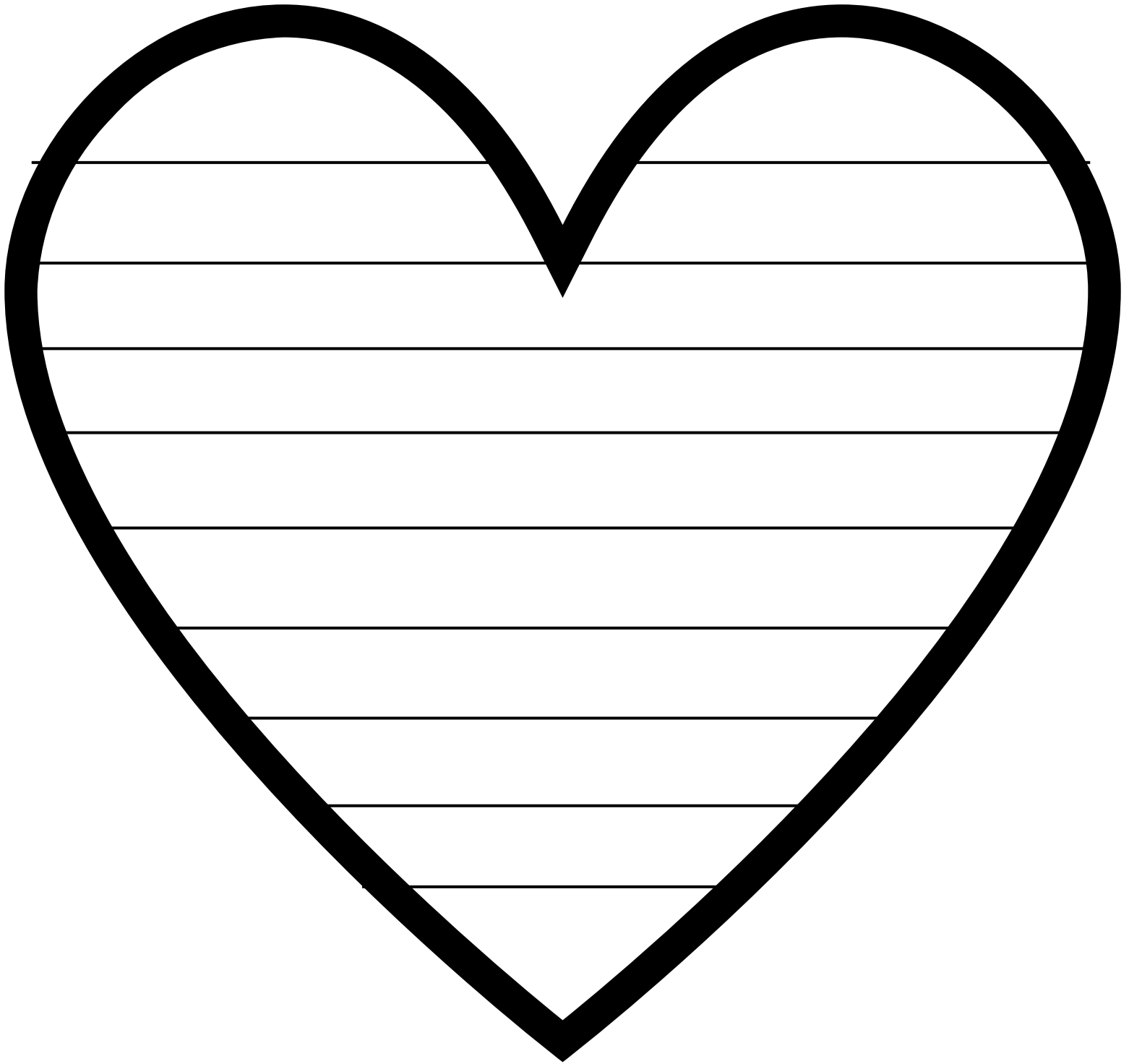
## The Boy Who Saved His World Heart Activity

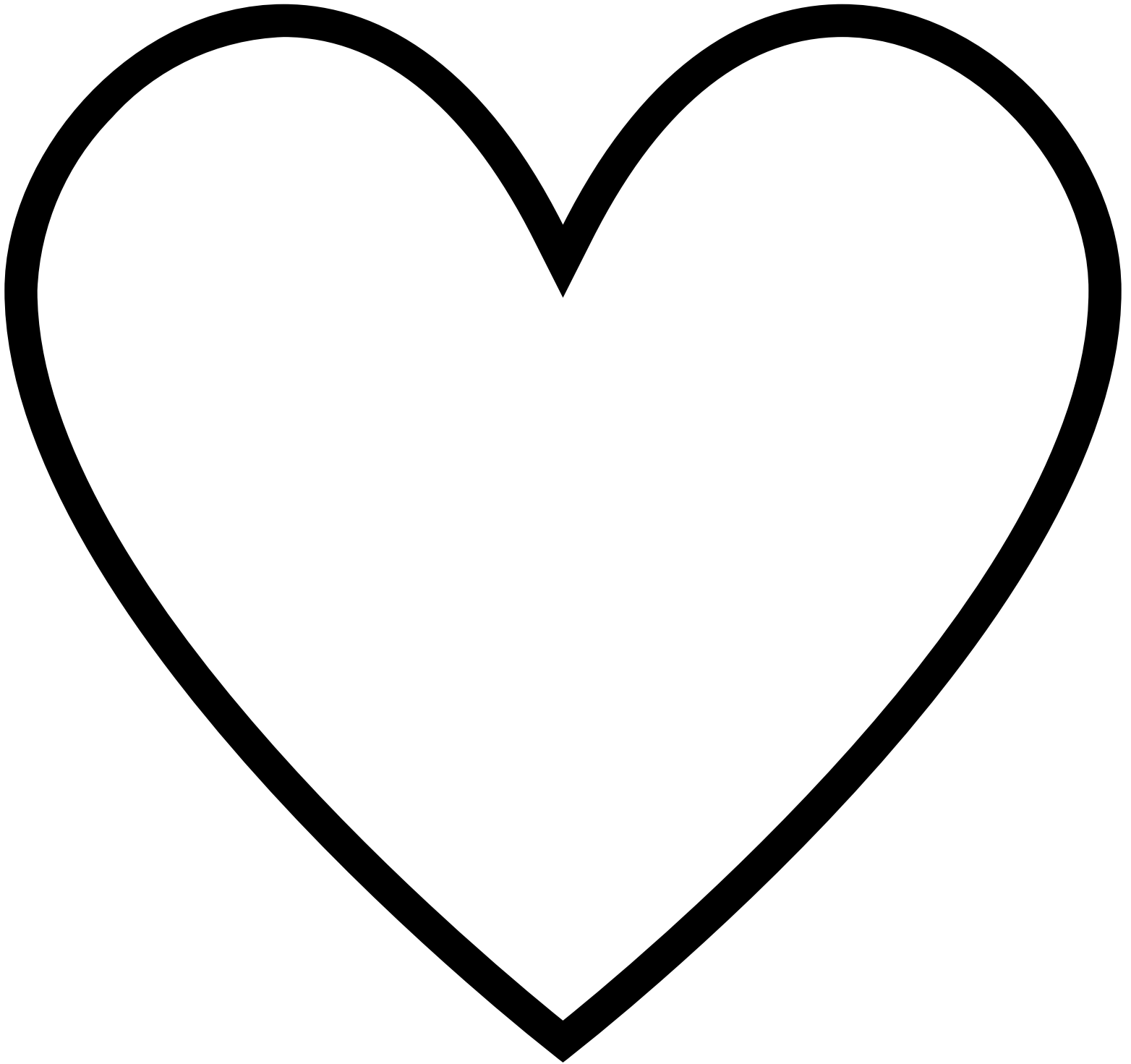
### Materials:
