

The Real Bargain Card Making Activity

Materials

- Construction paper
- Crayons
- Colored pencils
- Optional: stickers

Activity procedures

- 1. Explain to students that there are people all around us who may need our empathy and kindness.
- 2. Explain that even children can show empathy and do kind deeds for others, much like young Guru Nanak did!
- 3. Demonstrate options for how to create a greeting card with provided materials.
 - a. Provide students pre-printed words, or create a word list that students can copy from if they wish to write on the cards.
- 4. Explain to students that the teacher will collect cards and deliver/mail to chosen location/organization, which is showing kindness and caring for others.
 - a. Align this with the story, illustrating that it is not material possessions that are important, rather taking the time to show a simple kindness for another person when we are able to do so.
- 5. Send cards to elderly, community members, firemen, police, EMT, etc...

- 1. Ask the students how we can encourage people to donate to the local food bank.
- 2. Have the students do some research on the organization located in their community.
