

The Real Bargain Card Making Activity

Materials

- Construction paper
- Crayons
- Colored pencils
- Optional: stickers

Activity procedures

1. Explain to students that there are people all around us who may need our empathy and kindness.
2. Explain that even children can show empathy and do kind deeds for others, much like young Guru Nanak did!
3. Demonstrate options for how to create a greeting card with provided materials.
 - a. Provide students pre-printed words, or create a word list that students can copy from if they wish to write on the cards.
4. Explain to students that the teacher will collect cards and deliver/mail to chosen location/organization, which is showing kindness and caring for others.
 - a. Align this with the story, illustrating that it is not material possessions that are important, rather taking the time to show a simple kindness for another person when we are able to do so.
5. Send cards to elderly, community members, firemen, police, EMT, etc...
